Dear CPS Energy Customer,

CPS Energy is planning an upcoming project that will improve electric reliability in your neighborhood. The project will consist of rebuilding the existing high-voltage transmission line as well as tower (pole) and foundation replacements between the Hunt Lane Substation the Pinn Road Substation. CPS Energy's plan for this project is to rebuild this transmission line that is located within existing easements and street right of way.

The section of transmission line to be rebuilt begins at the southeast corner of Hunt Lane and Marbach Road and extends in an easterly direction/northeasterly direction to the Pinn Road Substation located just southeast of the intersection of Pinn Road and Westlawn Street. Currently, all of the transmission line and infrastructure affected by this project are located within easements which may be on or adjacent to your property or within street right of way.

CPS Energy plans to replace all existing lattice-type transmission towers with steel monopole structures. In addition, new foundations and associated wiring will be required. The first stage of the project is to have the existing easements surveyed in relation to existing property lines. McKim and Creed, a local surveying company, will be conducting the surveying for this project. You will receive additional correspondence regarding this project once more details have been finalized. A brochure outlining the project in further detail is enclosed for your information.
