This document is a guide to introduce the School Pipe Testing Portal to School Facilities.


Note: The steps shown below are a quick overview of the school gas pipe testing portal schools will access to enter tests due.

### **Receiving Access to submit School Pipe Test Portal**


School Administrators will receive an email similar to the one shown below.

#### Accessing the portal:

1. Click Hyperlink "Gas Pipe Test Results"











2. You will see a list of schools that are due for testing.





### **Entering School Pipe Test Results**

3. Click on the meter associated with the test record.






4. Click the bar with the Meter # to expand and check the box to enter pipe test information.


## CPS Energy School Gas Pipe Testing

The following information must be entered once the testing is complete. Please enter the full name of who performed the test(s), as well as the person who witnesses/verified the test and results.






5. Enter the results of the pipe test in the required fields. Do this for all tests performed.





6. You should receive a "Validated Successfully" notice if all information required has been submitted. Click "Save Test Results"





- 7. Authorization pop up appears
  - a. Enter Authorized By
  - b. Select Send to CPS Energy

Name of the individual authorizing this information is required. Please enter then name of who is submitting this information to CPS Energy. Once sent, the tested meters can no longer be updated.

In the event there are questions, the district and/or school representative will be contacted by CPS Energy Gas Compliance Department.

8. You should receive a pop up stating the pressure test was successfully updated. If the test is rejected, you will be contacted by CPS Energy Gas Compliance Department with further direction.
